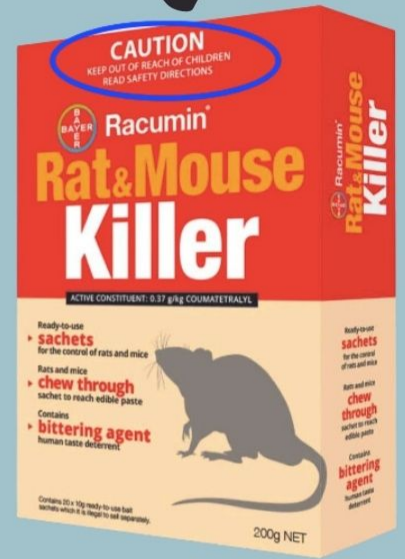
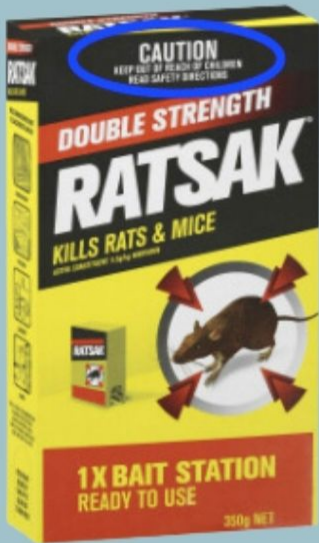

**'Quick-kill', 'one feed' Second Generation poisons not only kill rats and mice, but also animals that feed on the dead carcasses – birds of prey, possums, pet dogs, etc.**

These poisons can accumulate in the rodent's body to a very toxic level before death and persist for many months, even after death, retaining a lethal dose of poison for predators.

Safer First Generation poisons only accumulate in the rodent's body until death, then rapidly break down, thus minimising the likelihood of secondary poisoning of wildlife and pets.

**First Generation poisons are effective, easy to use, target the pest rodents, and come with a 'CAUTION' advice on the box – watch for this!**

**USE ONLY First Generation rodenticides (baits) that clearly display the 'CAUTION' label and have 'Warfarin' or 'Coumatetralyl' as the active ingredient.**

Only use these safer poisons if you have a mouse or rat problem.
